**Not allowed: Urban or suburban events or races, ad hoc wilderness medicine patient care without a duty to act.)**

**Search and Rescue team membership and training is awarded 1 credit for each full year. SAR team deployments are awarded additional credits based on their duration.**

**National Ski Patrol is awarded maximum 3 credits per season (November - May OR June - October**
